The Greater Atlanta Chapter of the Society of Fire Protection Engineers seeks candidates to receive an award from the Chapter Scholarship Fund.

The Scholarship Committee of the Greater Atlanta Chapter intends to award a total of \$2,500 to one or more students enrolled in a fire protection engineering, fire technology or fire science undergraduate or graduate program. The scholarship(s) is available to full-time, part-time, resident and distance-learning students. The scholarship(s) may be awarded to one or more qualifying candidates per the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, with an award amount(s) established by the Scholarship Committee.

The Scholarship Committee places no specific weighting on applicant qualifications, i.e. there is no minimum G.P.A. requirement. Nor does the recipient(s) have to meet all of the qualifications to receive an award. As such, scholarship award(s) are based on consideration of the following qualifications:

- Receipt of complete application by the date requested
- Receipt of letter of introduction as described on the Scholarship Application
- Complete academic transcript of all undergraduate and graduate programs
- Proof of permanent residence in the geographical area served by the Greater Atlanta Chapter of SFPE, or immediate/recent residence in the geographic area if the student is enrolled out-of-state
- Proof of SFPE membership, including student chapter membership
- Any other information the applicant feels would assist the Scholarship Committee in its selection process

Scholarship applications may be obtained by contacting Doug Fisher at the address, phone, or email listed above. Alternately, contact any Greater Atlanta Chapter Officer or Executive Committee member for an application. Applications are due to the Chapter by June 1, 2007. The scholarship award(s) will be selected by the Chapter Executive Committee by June 11, 2007. All candidates will be notified of the committee's decision by telephone/email or mail.

Scholarship award recipients agree to let the Greater Atlanta Chapter use their name and photo in award announcements. The Greater Atlanta Chapter does not guarantee any/all applicant(s) will receive a scholarship award, nor is the scholarship amount(s) guaranteed, nor is there any obligation to make an award.
